Biography

Dr. Stephan Doering is chair and professor of Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy at the Medical University of Vienna. He was born 1966 in Rotterdam (Netherlands) and grew up in Germany. He studied Medicine at the universities of Göttingen (Germany), Berlin and Jerusalem. He received his professional training at the medical schools of Münster (Germany) and Innsbruck (Austria). Dr. Doering specialized in Psychiatry and Psychotherapy as well as in Psychosomatics and Psychotherapy. He underwent psychoanalytical training at the Münchner Arbeitsgemeinschaft für Psychoanalyse (M.A.P.) between 1996 and 2003. From 2004 to 2010 he was professor of Psychosomatics in Dentistry at the University of Münster (Germany), before he was appointed as professor and chair at the Medical University of Vienna in 2011.

Dr. Doering's main research foci are psychotherapy research, diagnosis and treatment of personality disorders, psychosomatic medicine, and neurobiological aspects of psychotherapy. He published 63 articles in peer reviewed journals, 16 book chapters, and nine books. Moreover, he received five scientific awards.

Dr. Doering is editor of two scientific journals and member of numerous scientific associations. He is vice president of the Society for Research and Treatment of Personality Disorders (GePs).
