European Society for the Study of Personality Disorders (ESSPD)

The ESSPD stimulates and supports scholarship, clinical experience, international collaboration and communication of research on all aspects of personality disorders including epidemiology, etiology, diagnosis and assessment, course and treatment in Europe.

The ESSPD is based on democratic bylaws aimed at creating a clear outline of structure and rules. The individual members determine the society's policies. They have the right to choose the board members, and can vote on the plans and goals of the Society at the general meeting. The board also has to account for their pursued policy and financial affairs in the annual report presented at the general meeting.

European national personality disorder societies can apply for an association with the ESSPD. The members of the associated societies have the advantage of a discount on ESSPD congress admission fees and membership.

Each associated PD society has a seat in the ESSPD council which advises the ESSPD board.

Other European scientific societies can also apply for an associated society status. Their individual members have the same privileges as the associated PD societies; however they have no seat in the council.

Through its affiliation with Regional and National organizations the ESSPD encourages the initiative of education and research on personality disorders as well as collaborative efforts across countries and regions in Europe. The ESSPD is meant to be a society with a European signature which will address the specific needs of the European personality disorder field and actively will expand it to countries in which it is less developed.
